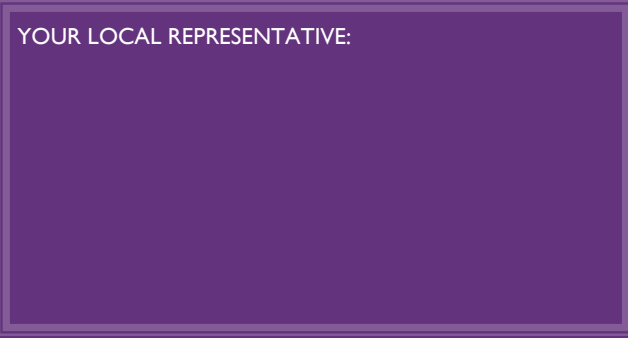

## INTENSIVE ENGLISH INTEGRATED SKILLS

During the Integrated Skills Class, students study four English skills - reading, writing, speaking, and listening - in a communicative way through a system called Community Language Teaching. Students use various activities to practice English conversation including listening tasks, role plays, and discussion. Practical reading and writing tasks and vocabulary studies are presented as well.

### ORAL COMMUNICATION

During the Oral Communication Class, students will cover a variety of topics while practicing English conversation management, American conversational styles, and pronunciation. Students learn commonly used American idioms and slang in a communicative way. Students use various activities to practice these new idioms including listening tasks, role plays, and discussion.

## TOEFL PREPARATION READING & WRITING SECTION

This section of the course focuses on the reading and writing sections of the test. A variety of reading exercises help students improve comprehension and learn the types of reading questions found on the test. Essay writing and other writing activities help students prepare for this important section of the exam. Multi-skill activities are practiced as well.

### LISTENING & SPEAKING SECTION

This section the course focuses on the listening and speaking sections of the test. A combination of Authentic English listening practice and TOEFL listening activities are used. Critical listening comprehension skills are the core learning focuses. In addition, integrated skills speaking activities and pronunciation practice makes up the remainder of the program.
